



MARGARET MEGLES-NORRIS

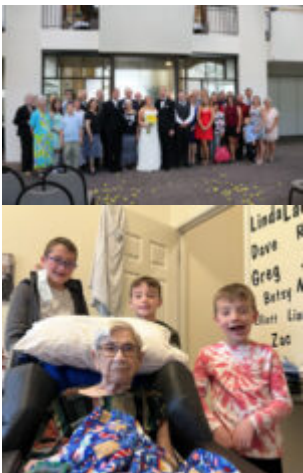
