Michael "Mike" Patrick Langin, age 60, of Fort Wayne, IN passed away at home, surrounded by family on Sunday, July 28, 2024. Born on January 18, 1964, he was the son of the late Patrick and Diane (Recht) Langin. Mike was a graduate of Bishop Dwenger High School. He worked as a Senior Lab Technician at Steel Dynamics.
